### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Currently in or aged out of the foster care system
- Residing in a congregate care setting within Bexar county
- Entering 8th-12th grades in Bexar County schools
  - San Antonio ISD
  - East Central ISD
  - Medina Valley ISD
  - Schertz-Cibolo-Universal City ISD
  - Northside ISD
  - Southwest ISD
  - Judson ISD
  - North East ISD
